

## POMERANIAN COAT COLORS

THEY ARE A WONDERFUL AND OUTSTANDING BREED WITH SO MANY BEAUTIFUL COLORS.

1. ORANGE: MAY VARY FROM AN INTENSE DEEP RUST RIGHT THROUGH TO A RICH GOLD AND A LIGHT BLONDE COLOR.



2. CREAM: IS AN EXTREMELY PALE ORANGE.



3. ORANGE SABLE: MUST HAVE AN ORANGE BODY, LIGHTER ORANGE, OR EVEN CREAMY UNDERCOAT WITH BLACK TIPPING ON GUARD HAIR.



4. BLACK: POSSESS A BLACK UNDERCOAT AND BLACK GUARD HAIRS.



5. BLACK AND TAN: IS A BASE BLACK COLOR WITH TAN POINTS.



6. WHITE: SHOULD BE A SOLID WHITE WITH NO LEMON OR CREAM SHADINGS.



7. WOLF SABLES: HAVE A REY UNDERCOAT AND THE GUARD HAIR IS S GRREY WITH BLACK TIPPING.

8. PARTI-COLOR PATTERN; IS WHITE WITH AANY COLOR DISTRIBUTED IN PATCHES WITH A WHITE BLAZE PREFERRED ON THE HEAD.

9. CHOCOLATE: IS A RICH BROWN.



10. CREAM SABLE: IS AN EXTREMELY PALE ORANGE -CREAM WITH SABLE TIPPING.

11. BLUE MERLE: A BLACK BASE COLOR COMBINED WITH THE MERLE PATTERN EQUALS A BLUE MERLE.

12. RED: IS A DEEP RUSTY COLOR.

13. CHOCOLATE AND TAN PATTERN: IS A BASE COLOR OF CHOCOLATE WITH TAN POINTS.

14. RED SABLE: ARE A DEEP RUSTY WITH SABLE TIPPINGS TO THE COAT.

15. TRI-COLOR: IS A PARTI -COLOR POMERANIAN WHO ALSO DISPLAYS THE TAN PATTERN AS WELL AS THE PARTI-COLOR PATTERN.

16. BLUE: ARE DILUTED BLACKS AND MUST HAVE TAN POINTS.

17. BLUE AND TAN PATTERN: IS A BASE COLOR WITH TAN POINTS.

18. BLUE SABLES: HAVE A BLUE BASE COAT WITH DARK GUARD HAIRS AND AGAIN ENDING IN BLACK TIPPING TO THE GUARD HAIRS.
19. CHOCOLATE MERLE: IS A CHOCOLATE BASE COLOR COMBINED WITH THE MERLE PATTERN.
20. BEAVER: MIGHT VARY IN COLOR FROM A LIGHT BISCUIT TO A DARK BROWNISH GREY COLOR WITH A SILVERY BLUE CAST TO THE COAT.
21. BLACK AND BRINDLE: THE BASE COLOR IS A GOLD, RED, OR ORANGE-BRINDLED WITH STRONG BLACK CROSS STRIPES.
22. CHOCOLATE SABLE: HAVE A CHOCOLATE BASE COAT WITH DARKER CHOCOLATE GUARD HAIRS.
23. LAVENDER: IS A GREYISH COLOR WITH A PINKISH, CHOCOLATE HUE TO THE COAT.
24. BLUE BRINDLE: THE BASE COLOR IS GOLD, RED, OR ORANGE-BRINDLED WITH STRONG BLUE STRIPS.
25. MERLE AND TAN: IS EITHER BLUE MERLE PATTERN WITH TAN POINTS OR CHOCOLATE MERLE WITH TAN POINTS.
