

PUPPY UGLY STAGE

WHEN POMERANIAN PUPPIES ARE BORN, THEY HAVE A SINGLE LAYER OF COAT EACH WEEK AS THEY GROW THEIR COAT STARTS COMING IN. AT 8 WEEKS SOME HAVE ADORABLE FLUFFY COATS OTHERS MIGHT NOT HAVE AS MUCH EACH POMERANIAN PUPPY IS DIFFERENT. WHEN A POMERANIAN PUPPY REACHES 3 TO 6 MONTHS, THEY WILL START TO LOSE THEIR SOFT PUPPY COAT. A POMERANIAN PUPPIES COAT WHEN GOING THRU THIS STAGE MAY APPEAR PATCHY AND SHAGGY. GRADUALLY AS YOUR POMERANIAN PUPPY AGES YOU WILL NOTICE HIS OR HER ADULT COAT SLOWLY COMING IN. REMEMBER EACH POMERANIAN IS DIFFERENT IT MIGHT TAKE UP TO 1 TO 3 YEARS FOR THE BEAUTIFUL FULL COAT TO COME IN COMPLETE.

IT IS VERY COMMON FOR YOUR POMERANIAN PUPPY COAT TO CHANGE COLOR. IT MAY DECREASE OR INCREASE NEWER HAIRS MAY BE DARKER OR LIGHTER.

POMERANIAN ADULT'S COATS REGARDS TO SHEDDING:

POMERANIANS AND OTHER LONG HAired DOG BREEDS DON'T SHED EACH AND EVERY DAY. IN CONTRAST TO SMOOTH COATED DOGS THAT ARE HEAVY SHEDDERS AND SHED A LOT OF COAT EACH DAY.

THE POMERANIAN SHEDDING CAN BE EASILY MANAGED WITH REGULAR BRUSHING. SHEDDING FOR MOST LONG COATED BREEDS IS SEASONAL. IN FEMALE POMERANIANS HORMONAL SHEDDING AFTER A SEASON OR AFTER WEANING A LITTER OF PUPS. MALE POMERANIAN HOLD THEIR ADULT COATS BETTER THAN FEMALES. (MOST TIMES YOU HAVE TO BRUSH A MALES COAT OUT.)
